HIGHLIGHTS OF KEY PROJECTS

Health and Hygiene school program conducted by ARTIST (Asian Research & Training Institute for Skill Transfer) at 80+ schools in Karnataka.

The purpose of the project Health & hygiene is to Create Awareness among young and growing girls on Menstrual health, Importance of right Nutrition & exercise in growing age. Common hygiene methods during the menstruation including Hand wash and Right way to dispose of the used pads, Awareness about cervical cancer vaccinations.



This collaborative effort creates opportunities to build capacity learning. Collaborating with school and community-based resources to reduce health-related barriers to student learning, improve access to healthcare, and also develop school-community partnerships to support academic achievement and student success.

In Bengaluru, Guinness record with sanitary napkins to promote menstrual hygiene

Participants formed a line stretching 1,078 metres using 10,105 sanitary pads.

To promote menstrual hygiene, especially among adolescents, gynaecologists attempted a Guinness world record by creating the 'longest line of sanitary pads' at the 62nd All India Congress of Obstetrics and Gynaecology (AICOG) that began in the city on Wednesday. Over 1,500 gynaecologists, led by the organising chairperson Hema Divakar, created a line of 1,078 metres using 10,105 sanitary pads. Depicting women's health, the sanitary pads were designed in the shape of a uterus and carried the tagline 'Nothing's more cuter than your uterus'.

PSI and ARTIST collaborate for Parivartan

Parivartan, thus aims to educate the women about Health, Hygiene, Contraception and more; right from the adolescent age, so that many issues related to family planning can be addressed.

Since there is a 10 fold increase in women delivering in hospitals due to maternity benefit scheme.

These women would now leave the hospital with a contraceptive in place.

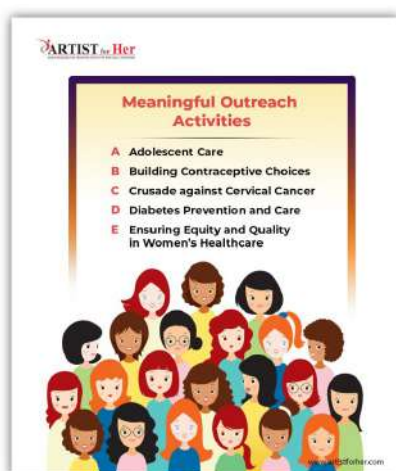
UGANDA CAN FIGHT CERVICAL CANCER, WHY CAN’T WE?

Two leading cervical cancer researchers, Dr Isaac Manyoda a gynaecologist with St George's Hospital in London and Dr Harshad Sanghvi, vice-president and medical director-Innovation Development at Jhpiego (an international, non-profit health organization affiliated with The Johns Hopkins University), Maryland, USA collaborating with ARTIST, as part of an awareness programme on cervical cancer immunisation.

ARTIST has trained health workers in administering the vaccine.

CERVICAL CANCER VACCINE PROMOTION

A nationwide campaign was conducted seeking to institutionalize vaccination against the Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) for girls in the age group of 9-13 years. The demands have to be met by strengthening the supply side and empower the mothers and daughters with the information and access to seek help. Mobile Apps and Online video chat, WhatsApp groups, Helpline, dedicated YouTube channels create access to information and ARTIST is exploring the use of digital technology to reach as far and as many in spreading awareness.

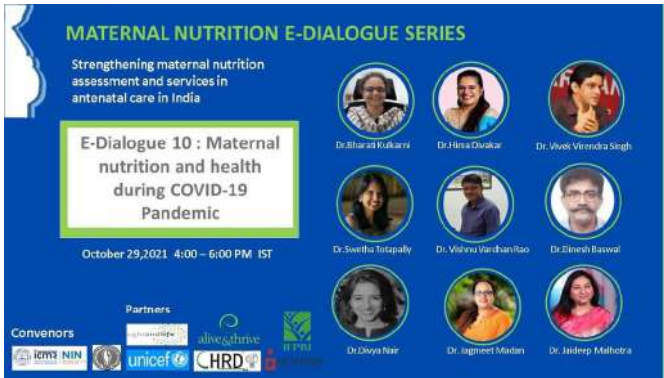

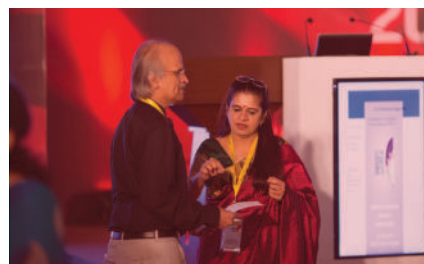
FOCUS AREA FOR PROGRAM STRATEGY

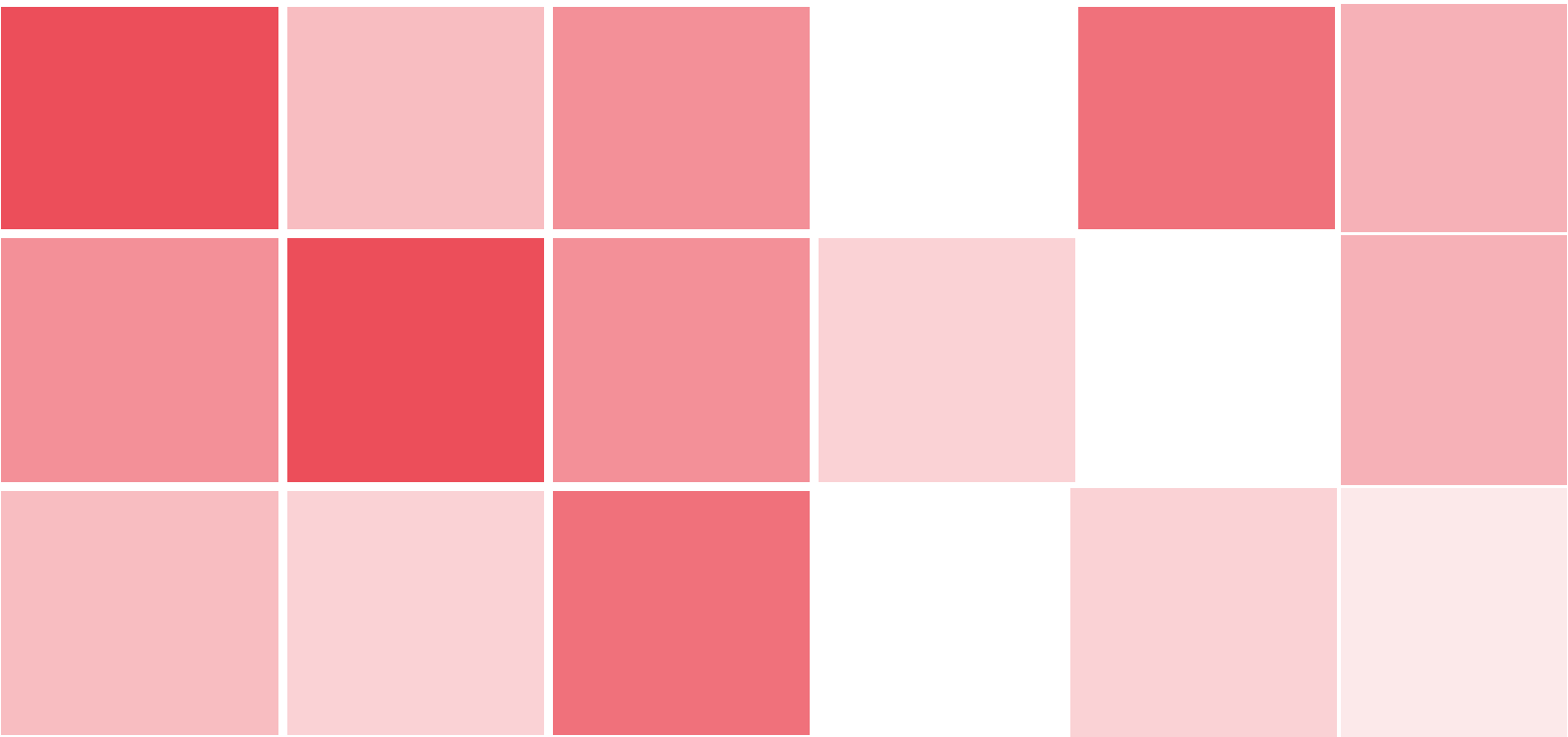
